Schedule of classes.

- 1 5 blooms, of any cultivar or cultivars, in one vase
- 2 3 blooms, any cultivar or cultivars, Division 6, in one vase.
- 3 3 blooms, any one cultivar in one vase. Excluding Div 6.
- 4 3 blooms, any one type, Division 13, in one vase.
- 5 1 bloom Division 1, yellow perianth.
- 6 1 bloom Division 1, white perianth.
- 7 1 bloom Division 2, yellow or orange perianth.
- 8 1 bloom Division 2, white perianth.
- 9 1 bloom Division 3.
- 10 1 bloom Division 4.
- 11 1 bloom Division 6, yellow perianth.
- 12 1 bloom Division 6, white perianth.
- 13 1 bloom Division 5,7, or 8.
- 14 1 bloom Division 11.
- 15 1 bloom, not showable in classes 5 to 14
- 16 A container of standard daffodils

Note - Miniature and intermediate cultivars should not be shown in these classes 1 to 16

Assessment classes*

- 17 6 miniature daffodils (species, wild hybrids, cultivars or seedlings), one bloom of each, staged in individual vases.
- 18 3 miniature species or wild hybrids, three blooms of each.
- 19 3 miniature cultivars or seedlings three blooms of each.
- 20 3 blooms of one miniature species or wild hybrid.
- 21 3 blooms of one miniature cultivar or seedling.
- 22 3 blooms of one cultivar from the Daffodil Society List of Approved Miniatures.
- 23 3 distinct miniature species or wild hybrids, one bloom of each, staged in one vase
- 24 3 distinct miniature cultivars or seedlings, one bloom of each, staged in one vase
- 25 3 distinct cultivars from the Daffodil Society List of Approved Miniatures, one bloom of each, staged in one vase

- 26 1 bloom of a miniature species or wild hybrid.
- 27 1 bloom of a miniature cultivar or seedling.
- 28 1 miniature bloom, divisions 1 to 4
- 29 1 miniature bloom, division 6.
- 30 1 miniature bloom, division 10
- 31 1 miniature bloom, divisions 5 or 7 to 12 excluding 10
- 32 A container not exceeding 20cm in diameter of miniature daffodils in growth
- 33 A container exceeding 20cm in diameter of miniature daffodils in growth

Note - In the assessment classes 16 to 32, a miniature daffodil is defined as being less than 50mm in diameter but unless stated otherwise it does not need to be on the Daffodil Society list of Approved Miniatures

- 34 3 intermediate daffodils any cultivar or cultivars, seedling or seedlings
- 35 1 intermediate daffodil or seedling

Note - In the assessment classes 34 to 35, an intermediate daffodil is defined as being less than 85mm in diameter but unless stated otherwise it does not need to be on the Daffodil Society list of Approved Intermediates
