Notes - Division and colour to be as registered

Restricted cultivars* are those on the Daffodil Society List or were registered before 1985

A miniature* daffodil (species or wild hybrid, cultivar or seedling), is defined as being less than 50mm in diameter

An intermediate* cultivar is defined as being less than 85mm in diameter
